GOALS

Determine current level of club participation in these programs and seek an ambitious but realistic increase in club sponsorship of both the Peace Poster Contest and the GOOD Program.

- Peace Poster: Target = at least one sponsored participant per school district.

EXPECTATIONS

- Be thoroughly familiar with all aspects of both the Peace Poster Contest and GOOD Program.
- Promote awareness of the Peace Poster Contest among all Lions through club and zone meeting presentations, newsletter articles, etc...especially during the late spring, summer and fall periods during which the contest runs. Assist clubs in starting the program in their own communities.
- Promote awareness of the GOOD Program among all Lions through club and zone meeting presentations, newsletter articles, etc...especially during the winter and early spring periods. Assist clubs in starting the program in their own communities.
- Consult frequently with the MD13 Youth committee member to coordinate with any statewide efforts and to report progress on a statewide level. Consult regularly with the Governor regarding progress and any issues that may arise.
- Report on Peace Poster and GOOD Program progress at all Cabinet Meetings and the District Convention.
