LCIF IN SUPPORT OF VENEZUELA EARTHQUAKES
FIRST ON THE GROUND RECENT FLOODS IN KENTUCKY**

TO THE LIONS OF OHIO

VENEZUELA EARTHQUAKE DISASTER

LCIF has allocated USD\$200,000.00 for immediate relief following the recent earthquakes in Venezuela. This funding is aimed at empowering local Lions clubs to provide immediate assistance and support for long-term recovery efforts.

Humanitarian Needs:

The humanitarian situation in Venezuela is now critical, with UNICEF estimating a need for 183 million USD to address the urgent needs that are affecting 3.3 million people including 1.8 million children. LCIF supports part of a broader effort to deliver life saving assistance to those impacted by the ongoing earthquakes .

Community Impact:

Local Venezuela Lions Clubs and Lions clubs worldwide are mobilizing to deliver aid demonstrating the foundations commitment to community empowerment and support. The responses include not only financial assistance but also logistical support to ensure effective resources needed.

KENTUCKY FLOODING

LCIF has now provided significant support for flood relief efforts in affected areas of Kentucky.

LCIF has allocated USD\$100,000.00 in designated disaster funding to assist with the immediate needs following the recent flooding in Kentucky. Additionally, since the flooding began, LCIF has been awarded an extra USD\$95,000.00 in emergency

relief grants to further support the recovery efforts. LCIF was the first on the ground and continues to be diligent in affirming its assistance to those in need.

My personal plea is that I respectfully ask that the Lions and clubs of Ohio come forward and open your hearts and support LCIF during these two crisis events.

There is nothing more essential to being a Lion than service. Through our support of LCIF, the foundation will continue to provide the resources needed to take on those issues that we care about, bringing about real and lasting change.
