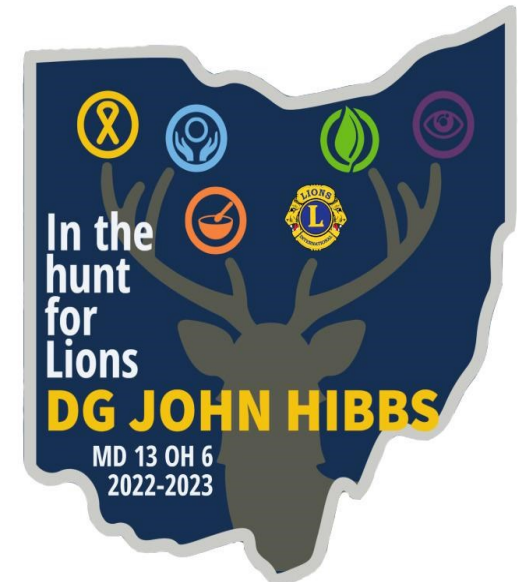
—From I75 take I275 east to Reed Hartman Hwy, right appx 2 m & rt onto Lake Forest Dr
