Carol Carey, wife of PDG Jay Carey, passed out at dinner last night and became disoriented. Jay called the emergency squad after clearing her throat of food so she would not choke and breathe better. The Squad took her to Fayette Memorial Hospital in Washington CH and realized quickly that she needed life flight to OSU Medical Center in Columbus. It was Carol's first time in a helicopter.

She had an aneurysm. Surgery was Friday between 11:30 am – 3:30 pm to drain the build-up of fluid on the brain. The surgeon team was optimistic that she will recover after 7 days in the hospital. She is heavily sedated and has been unable to communicate.
